AD HOC SUB-COMMITTEE OF THE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE COMMITTEE

12. A Sub-Committee was appointed at the 8th meeting of the Technical Assistance Committee, 6 February 1951, to make recommendations concerning the content of future reports of the Technical Assistance Board. At the 10th meeting of the Committee, 7 February 1951, France, India and the United States of America were nominated members. The Sub-Committee held one meeting on 7 February 1951 under the chairmanship of Sir Ramaswami Mudaliar (India), and its report (E/TAC/L.6) was

presented to the 11th meeting of the Committee, 26 February 1951.
