# INTRODUCTION

The General Assembly, composed of all Member States, is the main deliberative organ of the United Nations, and has the right to discuss and make recommendations on all matters within the scope of the Charter. The General Assembly meets once a year in regular session; special and emergency sessions are called as the need arises.

The Index to Proceedings of the General Assembly is a bibliographic guide to the proceedings and documentation of the General Assembly. This issue covers the ninth emergency special session, the second part of the seventh emergency special session, and the twelfth special session, as well as their Main and Ad Hoc Committees that met during the sessions. The Index is prepared by the Dag Hammarskjöld Library as one of the products of the United Nations Bibliographic Information System.

## THE ARRANGEMENT OF THIS INDEX

The Index consists of the following parts:

Introduction includes information on the documents of the General Assembly and how they may be obtained.

Abbreviations lists the abbreviations used throughout the publication.

The Index is then further divided into three sections, one for each session which met during the year. The sections are as follows:

Introduction includes a list of officers, rules of procedure, resolutions and decisions and a checklist of meetings for each session.

Agenda lists matters considered by and brought before the General Assembly and the subject headings under which these items are listed in the Subject Index.

Subject Index provides topical access to General Assembly documentation. It contains an alphabetical arrangement of subjects listed in the Agenda, as well as a list of documents considered under each item, at which meetings the items were considered, and, where applicable, the action taken by the General Assembly.

Index to speeches gives access to speeches that were made before the General Assembly. Speeches and statements by representatives are listed in alphabetical order by country or organization, subdivided by subject discussed and by name of speaker, with an indication of the meeting at which the speech was made. Addresses of Heads of State are listed under the name of the country they represent followed by their title and name. Non-procedural remarks by the President of the General Assembly and other officers are included. Statements by chairmen and rapporteurs of committees are included when they presented or explained the reports of their committees in plenary meetings. Statements and speeches made by individuals representing an organization to which a hearing was granted are listed under the name of the organization. Statements made by officers of the United Nations Secretariat are listed under the name of the office or department they represented.

Numerical list of documents contains a listing of documents arranged by symbol. This list also contains information regarding the republication of mimeographed documents in printed Official Records.

An Annex to the entire volume contains a voting chart of resolutions which were adopted by roll-call or recorded vote for all three sessions.

## DOCUMENTATION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Documents and meeting records for the thirty-first and subsequent sessions of the General Assembly are numbered in separate series by session, and not consecutively as had previously been done. For series symbols, the session is given in Arabic numerals, immediately following the indication of the body concerned, while the final element gives the serial number within the particular series concerned. A/ES-9/2, for example, is the second in the series of main documents for the General Assembly at its ninth emergency special session; A/S-12/AC.1/L.4 is the fourth in the series of limited distribution documents for the Ad Hoc Committee of the twelfth special session. The numbering of meetings is recorded in a similar way. The first plenary meeting of the ninth emergency special session of the General Assembly bears the symbol A/ES-9/PV.1; the record of the second meeting of the Ad Hoc Committee of the twelfth special session is cited as A/S-12/AC.1/SR.2.

The verbatim records of the plenary meetings of each session are first issued in provisional mimeographed form for limited distribution, and later issued in corrected printed form as Official Records for general distribution. The summary records of the Ad Hoc Committee (twelfth special session) are issued in provisional mimeographed form, with corrections issued in one Special Fascicle for all the meetings.

Of the other documents, a few appear as printed Supplements to the Official Records (so indicated in this index), and the rest are issued in mimeographed form. Some of these documents, such as the reports of committees on various agenda items, are subsequently printed in the Annexes to the Official Records. Resolutions adopted by the General Assembly, first issued in mimeographed form, are collected in printed Supplements to the Official Records of each session. After their republication in the Official Records, provisional mimeographed documents are no longer available. Lists of documents of each session are included in the Official Records bound volume of verbatim records of the plenary meetings, and also in this volume as the last section for each session.

## (SECOND PART - 1982)

### Introduction

The seventh emergency special session of the General Assembly, which was adjourned at the close of its 20th meeting, 29 July 1980, was resumed pursuant to its resolution ES-7/2 on 20 April 1982. In accordance with resolution ES-7/4 the session was adjourned at the close of the 21st meeting on 28 April and resumed at the 22nd meeting on 25 June. In accordance with resolution ES-7/5 the session was adjourned at the close of the 24th meeting on 26 June and resumed at the 25th meeting on 16 August. In accordance with resolution ES-7/6 the session was adjourned at the close of the 31st meeting on 19 August.

In accordance with paragraph 12 of resolution ES-7/6, the session was resumed at the 32nd meeting by the President of the 37th session. The Assembly then decided at the same meeting that the Vice-Presidents and the Credentials Committee of the 37th session would now serve in these capacities for the resumed emergency special session.
