AGENDA

The Council's practice is to adopt at each meeting, on the basis of a provisional agenda circulated in advance, the agenda for that particular meeting. At subsequent meetings an item may appear in its original form or with the addition of such sub-items as the Council may decide to include. An item once included in the agenda thereafter remains on the list of matters of which the Council is seized, until the Council agrees to its removal.

The agenda as adopted for each meeting in 1983 will be found in the Official Records of the Security Council, thirty-eighth year, S/PV.2411-2508. A chronological list of matters considered by, or brought to the attention of, the Council during 1983 appears below. A list of weekly summary statements of matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration, submitted by the Secretary-General under rule 11 of the Provisional Rules of Procedure of the Security Council, appears in the Subject Index under the heading "UN. Security Council (1983): agenda: summary statements".

The words which follow the title of each item and introduced by the word "See" indicate the subject heading under which the related documentation is listed in the Subject Index.
